CIE A level & AS Results – 11th August 2026

Cambridge International release AS and A level results earlier than JCQ examination boards, this year's CIE results will be available on Tuesday 11th August 2026. Your results will be available on the Engage portal after 10:30am UK time, please ensure you can access the portal in advance.

A Level Results Day – 13th August 2026

The A level results will be available in the **Hall on Thursday 13th August from 8.00 am**. All students are strongly advised to collect their results in person as we have senior leadership, teaching staff and our careers adviser on hand to help with any enquiries regarding university places, including clearing (please see separate details). Attendance in person is the quickest and most reliable way to obtain your results.

If students are not able to collect their results in person, they can login to the Engage portal to view them. We will aim to have the results uploaded by 10am. *Results may be available on Engage before 10am, but we cannot guarantee this, so we urge students to collect their results in person if at all possible.*

GCSE Results Day – 20th August 2026

The GCSE results will be available in the **Library on Thursday 20th August from 9.00 am**. All students are strongly advised to collect their results in person ideally with a family member. If students are continuing with us for A Levels, they will also need to meet with Anj or Mike to finalise their A Level programme.

What if I'm unable to come into college to collect my results?

If you know you will be out of the country or otherwise unavailable, please contact our Exams Officer Sarah Hayward to let her know. Your results will be available on the Engage portal later that morning. Please ensure you can access the Engage portal prior to results day.

Can my parents collect my results?

We are not able to give results to a third party without your written permission; this includes to friends and family members. If you want a third party to collect your results, you must email Sarah Hayward to give permission for them to collect your results.

What if I have concerns on results day about my results or my university choices?

College will be open from results day onward for any further advice that you may need in relation to results or university options. Please find attached important information about post results services available, these services are in place to assist students who may be unhappy with an exam result. Please make sure you read this information carefully and pay close attention to deadlines.
